#### Fund manager's commentary

The Federal Reserve raised interest rates in December to 1.25-1.5%. Since the previous policy-setting meeting, US economic growth has proved stronger and unemployment lower than expected while inflation has been as expected by the Federal Open Markets Committee. President Trump's tax cuts may lead to stronger growth in 2018, prompting further rate rises. In response, US equities lagged, rising 1.18% in sterling while global equity markets gained 1.71%. Financial stocks should, however, benefit from rising longer-term interest rates and the WAY Global Cautious Portfolio's holding in the SPDR S&P US Financials exchange-traded fund (ETF) outperformed, gaining 1.99%. UK equities gained 5.03% as Brexit talks progressed and entered their second phase, which will include trade. All the UK equity holdings lagged, however, with Aberforth UK Smaller Companies doing worst among the large holdings, up just 2.42%. Commodity prices strengthened, with oil rising 5.37% in sterling as Russia and members of Opec honoured their supply agreements while copper rose 7.17% on Chinese production cuts. In response, emerging market equities outperformed, rising 3.71%. Goldman Sachs Emerging Markets Equity was the portfolio's best performer, rising 3.73%. Investment in absolute return funds, which may generate modest positive returns irrespective of market trends, increased through the addition of Smith & Williamson Enterprise. Man GLG UK Absolute Value, which has a similar investment approach, returned 1.21%. The portfolio's bond investments lagged, with Man GLG Global Emerging Markets Debt doing worst, down 0.90%. 




